Notice for Foreign Students studying in MBBS/BDS Course in Bangladesh

This is to inform that the Directorate General of Health Services of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Bangladesh has decided to resume the final examination of the MBBS/BDS Course of May and July-2020 Term in the 3rd week of October 2020 or nearest possible time.

As per the health advisory and examination-related guidelines of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare of Bangladesh, foreign students will require to come to Bangladesh and stay at hostel at least 30 days before the commencement of examination and will need to comply with mandatory quarantine for 14 days. Everyone must carry out COVID-19 Negative Certificate.
